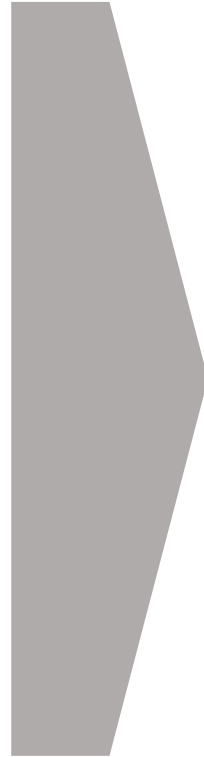

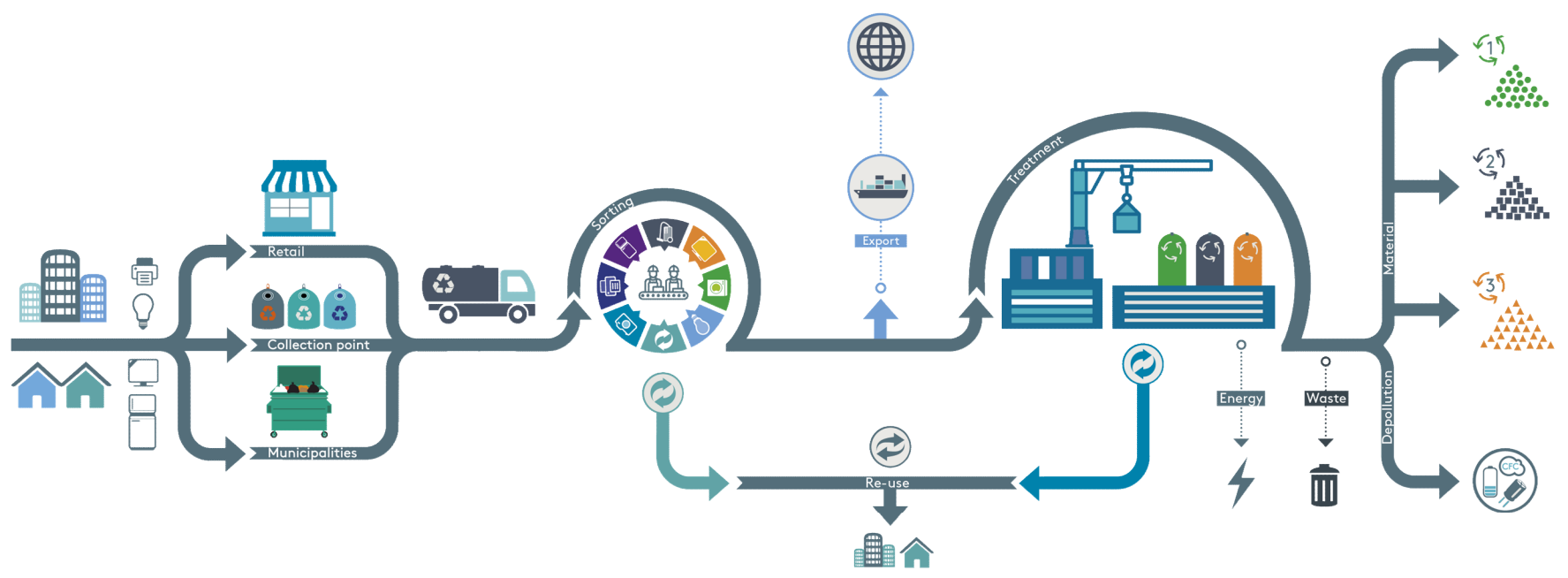

- All waste transfers are backed by a Consignment Note
- All Refrigeration is stored pending Export

Taking on the E-Waste Challenge

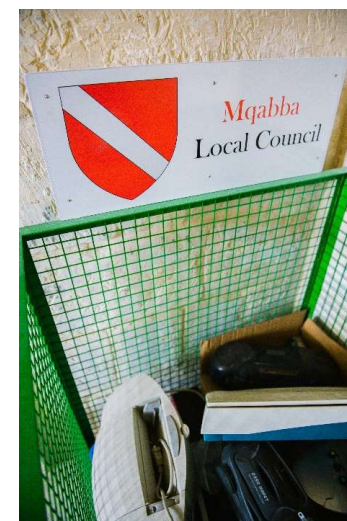
WEEE Trolley Campaign

95 Collection points

- 46 in Local Councils
- 23 business establishments
- 26 Schools



- 14 tons of small WEEE collected in the first 9 months of the year
- All diverted from landfill to appropriate facilities
- Mainly SHG, Tools and IT equipment

Waste Packaging Compliance Scheme

- ▶ Extended Producer Responsibility
- ▶ Manages the collection and recovery of packaging material like paper, cardboard, plastic, metal, glass and wood.
- ▶ 1200 producer member, 19,000 tons of MP; 13,100 tons collected (60% of POM - over national target)

WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

- ▶ Operates in 27 local councils
- ▶ Over 100 collection points
- ▶ 21 waste collectors
- ▶ 3 waste packaging facilities
